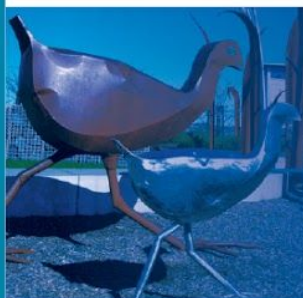

Parent Orientation Sessions

Research shows that children's learning is improved when parents are more aware of what that learning is about, so we encourage you to make the most of these opportunities.

Sessions are held on different dates so that you aren't caught having to be in two places at once.

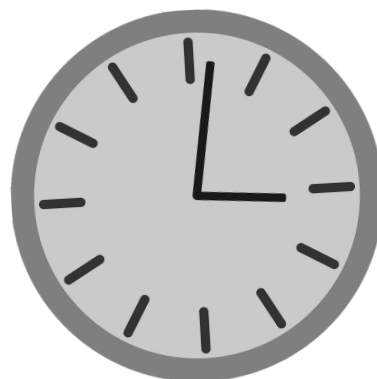

What happens after 3.00 pm??

At 3.00 pm, most children walk home. Some go to Kids Club, and others are picked up by parents or grandparents etc. This all works fine.

We have a number of children who get picked up later, usually between 3.15 and 3.30 pm. For these children, we have very clear expectations about where they are expected to be.

library. This is a safety expectation, and all waiting children are expected to abide by it. Please do not tell your children to wait by the car park, as they will not be there. The same goes for other places. If you want to pick your child up from school after 3.15 pm, they will be outside the Library only.

Note: We do get some children who wait by the front gates for their pick up. If you get to them by 3.15 pm, that will work fine. However, once 3.15 pm arrives, and the Road Wardens come off duty, those children still waiting must then move to wait outside the Library.

Head lice (or nits as commonly called) can become a pesky problem for many students during the year. We are fortunate to have a large supply of treatment (shampoo, nit combs etc) in our school office courtesy of KidsCan. We welcome any family to come and collect a pack to keep on standby at home in the event that your child needs to use it to treat a case of head lice. It is much better to have the treatment on hand and ready to use rather than to have to get to the chemist (often the day after you've become aware of the problem). Not to mention, it saves you paying for the treatments too!
